Test results must be picked up in person. Results will not be delivered by phone or email.



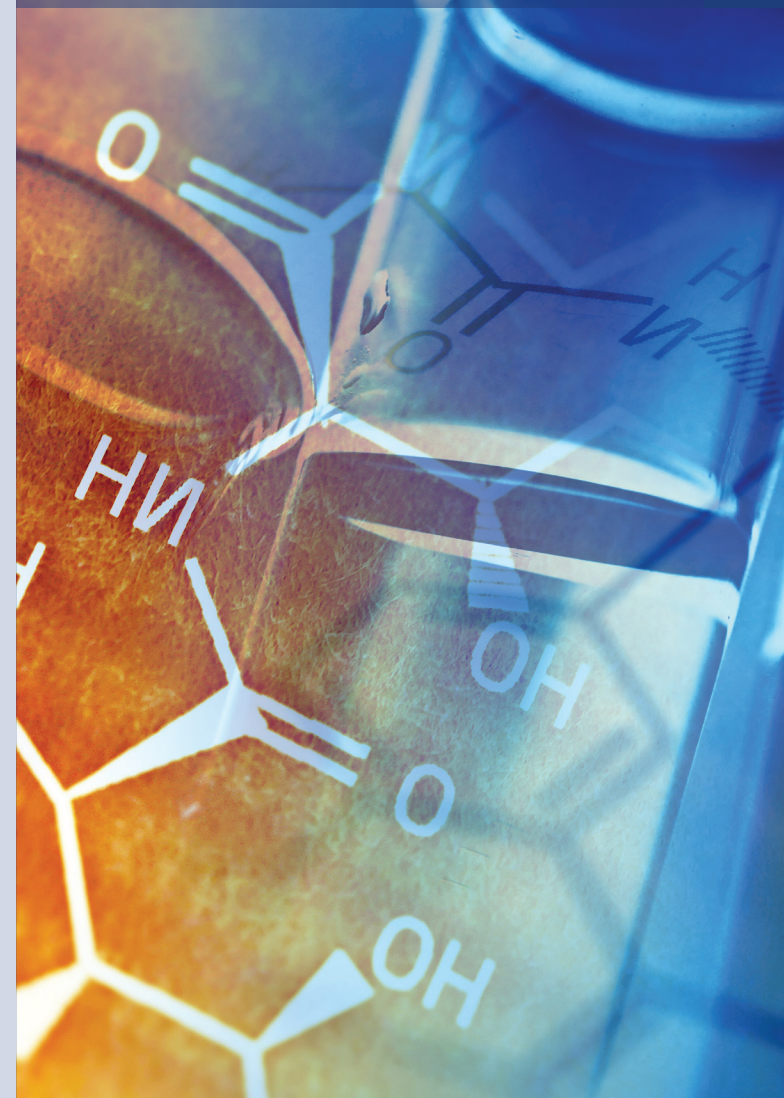
